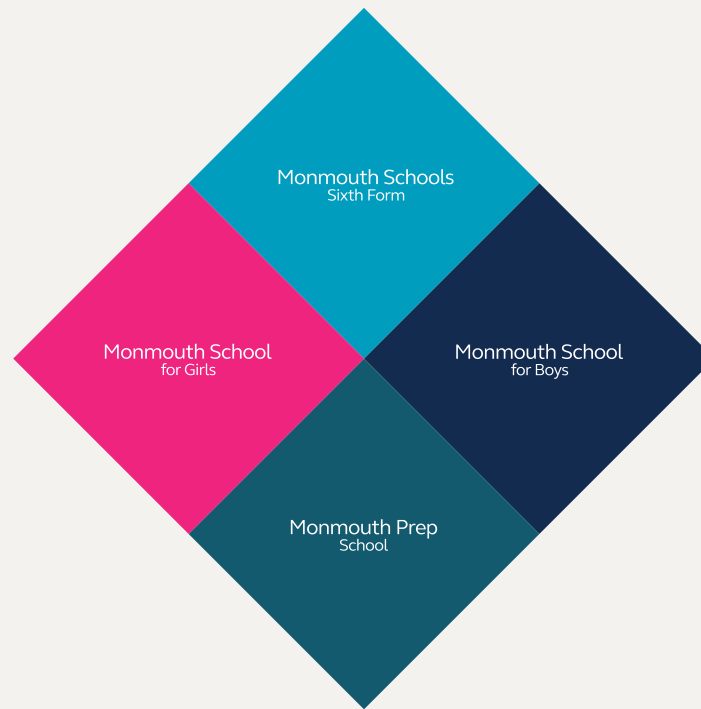

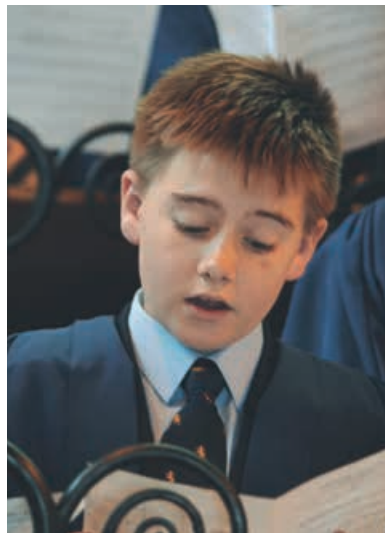




We offer a broad, stimulating choice of subjects which are taught in a tailored and structured way to suit the boys' style of learning.

Our Sixth Form students benefit from a co-educational academic experience and excellent pastoral care.



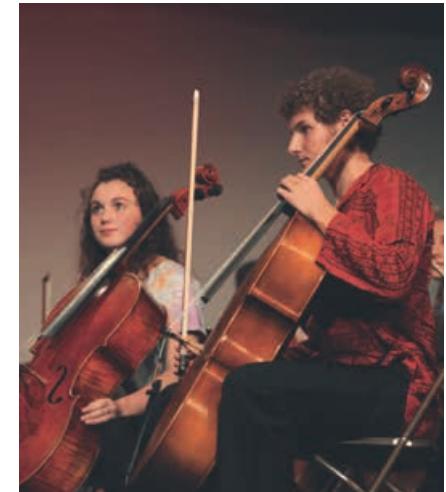

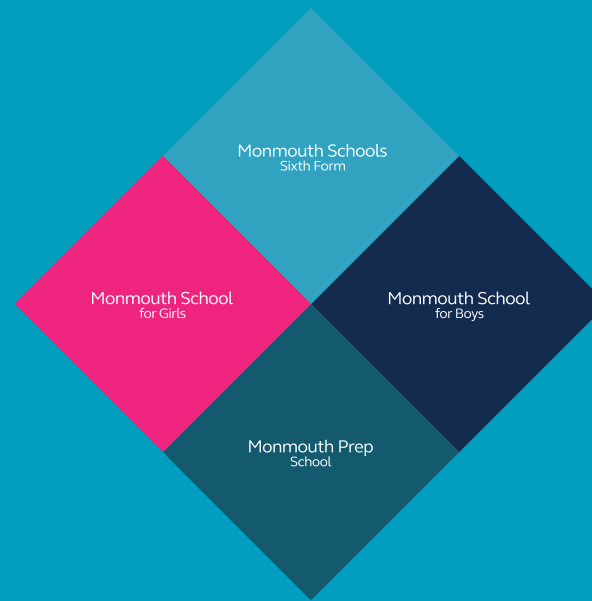
